1.) Click on the blue "AAUW Login page" link in the email that you will be, or already have received from AAUW or go directly to aauw.org. If you have visited the Community Hub before and remember your password you can log into your Personal Snapshot. If you have not, click Forgot Your Password located below the blue login button at the bottom of the page. Enter your email address then click Reset Your Password to receive a login email from infost@aauw.org. PLEASE DO NOT CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT! After you receive the login email, enter your email address and "Create and Confirm your Password" to access your Personal Snapshot.

2.) Within your **Personal Snapshot**, click the blue **RENEW** button at the bottom of the screen to update your profile and renew your national, branch CT-1022 Lower Conn Valley, and CT State memberships. (Dual members should self-renew ALL memberships at once.) You can pay using your credit card.

We had a beautiful day for our May hike at the Stewart B. McKinney National Wildlife Refuge's Salt Meadow Unit in Westbrook. As a bonus, Shakira, from the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, treated us to a tour of the home of feminist leaders Elizabeth Fisher Read and Esther Lape, who moved here from New York in 1927. Among its features are wrought iron balcony railings salvaged from New York's Waldorf Astoria. We were even allowed to go out on the balcony!

Eleanor Roosevelt was a frequent visitor here. A plaque outside the building includes a quote from a "My Day" newspaper column. It was written in 1945 by Eleanor, a few months after the death of her husband, President Franklin D. Roosevelt: "...in the evening we stood on an upstairs porch and saw the moon shine on the fields, with the background of Long Island Sound in the distance."
