These concepts found their way into our Constitution and Bill of Rights.

As a sidenote, Rick shared that Paul Revere did not say 'The British are coming!" on his midnight ride because everyone was British. He said, "The Regulars are Coming!"

To conclude, copies of the Declaration were passed out to a few members who read meaningful portions of it. An interesting and meaningful evening was had by all!
